METAL INDUSTRY OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

- On average makes about 20,3% of total exports of B&H
- ¼ of the total production of B&H
- Positive trade balance in most of its segments
- Low value-added products → Low participation in GDP (from cc.4%)
- The key production chains are: automotive parts, aluminum joinery and construction elements
- Skilled and expirenced workforce, favorable labor cost (200 € for the unskilled, and €
 770 for the highly skilled) In 2014 total number employess in metal sector was 23.069
- The most common export markets are the countries of the Western Balkans,
 Germany, Italy, Austria and Scandinavia



METAL INDUSTRY OF SERBIA

- About 31,000 employees work for 2,000 companies
- The share of the sector's employees in the total number of employees in Serbia is 2.4%, and the share of companies in their total number in Serbia is 3.5%
- The share of this industry in the total physical volume of industrial production in 2014 was 4%.
- The share of this part in GDP in 2013 was 1.4%
- Physical production volume of metal products in 2014 was lower by 24.7% as compared with 2013. Increase in production was recorded only in: steam boilers (272%), metal structures and blades, whereas decline was recorded with other products.
- The most common export markets are Russian Federation, Germany and Bosnia and Herzegovina



METAL INDUSTRY OF TURKEY

- The industry enjoyed high growth rates until the global recession in 2009. However, the industry recovered spectacularly and demonstrated a growth rate of 29.7% between the years 2010 and 2012. .
- Total export of Metal sector in 2014 was 49.3 bilion €
- According to the Ministry of Science, Industry and Technology, the machinery industry utilizes approximately 85% domestic input in the production stage, which in turn, reduces its dependency on foreign suppliers.
- Turkey's proportion in global automotive production has risen from 0.53% in 1999 to 1.24% in 2012, which ranked Turkey 17th in the global automotive manufacturing arena with over 1 million units produced. The most common export markets are United Kingdom, Germany, France, Italy
