

2nd Largest South American State of the future 2016/2017




Contributes with the 4% of the national GDP with USD\$10.5B (2014)



CONNECTIVITY



Located at less than 100Km to Santa Marta and Cartagena Port Areas

2 Fourth Generation (4G) roads that connect with the state with the inner cities of the country



Proximity to USA (two and a half hour) and Panama (one hour) by air

Less than one hour to 920 international and 6.125 domestic air frequencies per week



Connection with 459 ports in 122 countries in all 5 continents

Located at 99 nautical miles from Cartagena's port and at 52 from Santa Marta's


- Over 750 programs and 32 institutions of higher education
- Barranquilla has a population of approximately 60,000 bilingual inhabitants
- 11 language institutions
- We have 18 private bilingual schools, 4 of them with international high school
- 178 public schools to attend a 200.000 students population
- 3 of the best public schools in Colombia in 2016
- 44% of the engineers graduated between 2001 and 2014 in the Colombian Caribbean Region were trained in Barranquilla
- The Technical Secretary for the Metals sector programs of SENA (National Learning Service) is located in the state of Atlantico






EVENTS AND CONVENTION CENTER PUERTA DE ORO

- Modern complex for events and conventions development and Public Private Partnership (PPP) national model
- 75.500 m2 of total area
- The project includes:
 - Exhibition Center with a 16.000 people capacity
 - Convention Center with 4.000 people capacity
 - Touristic Boardwalk of 580 meters in lenght
 - Business Center Area
- USD\$124 million investment and 27.752 jobs during its construction






