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Investment in Tunisia

why invest?

Favorable destination for FDI

foreign companies have started to settle in large numbers and the country has become an offshore destination of choice:

- Foreign direct investment, on the other hand, accounts for around 10% of gross fixed capital formation (GFCF).
- 3455 foreign companies are established in Tunisia, providing over 376,470 jobs

Attractive regulation

- Freedom of investment and market access
- Simplicity in settlement procedures
- Protection of intellectual property
- Flexibility in recruitment procedures

Infrastructure

- Airport and maritime infrastructure: 9 international airports, 7 commercial ports and an oil terminal
- Telecommunications Infrastructure: use of fiber optics, SDH, ATM, ADSL and other broadband wireless bandwidths that can provide high capacity and speed for voice and data transmissions
- Industrial Infrastructure : 152 zones industrials

pool of skills

- An efficient educational system: 99% enrollment rate; 6,654 educational institutions; 268 academic institutions including 65 private; more than 1,000 vocational training centers.
- Qualified human resources: 65,000 new graduates; more than 300,000 registered academics.

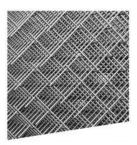
