








- ✤ 77% of arrivals were by air; the remainder were by land and sea.
- More than 1.7 million air arrivals landed at San Jose's Juan Santamaría International Airport (SJO). Daniel Oduber Airport in Liberia (LIR).
- ✤ Air arrivals to Costa Rica from Europe surpassed 480,000.
- Arrivals from other major European source markets were as follows: Germany – 74,574; Spain – 68,634; France – 74,032; Netherlands – 32,561.














### Arrivals and average growth percentage of four years








## Average stay per person










### Average Stay comparison. Year 2014










### Through which ways visiting Costa Rica attracted people?








### How they organized their trips? Percentages








### Who accompanied them during their trips?










### Tourist profile according to activities carried out (percentages)






### Tourist profile according to activities carried out (percentages)









### **Competitiveness Index of Costa Rica**








### **Comparative Tourism Competitiveness**
